

# Are you addicted to your eyeglasses?

Imagine losing your eyeglasses or contacts and being unable to replace them. Could you learn to see through the blur? How would you learn to see? Would you have withdrawal symptoms? Are you possibly addicted to your "seeing" devices? The addictive process of wearing eyeglasses and contacts is quite subtle. As we progress through childhood, we are conditioned to believe that eyeglasses are the only viable solution for "correcting" blurry sight. Invariably, the school nurse was the person who uncovered the eye "problem".

Further imprinting and justification for eyeglasses came from our parents, who in many cases, also made use of eye devices. Finally, the addictive process was cemented by our eye doctors's confirmation that we could not see and needed eyeglasses. The more we wore eyeglasses, the more we became dependent upon them.

There are a variety of methods for dealing with vision improvement from many other parts of the world that do not usually make it into the traditional eye doctor's educational training. Implementing vision fitness strategies such as focused breathing, games for the eyes and brain, patches, light, colour, body movements, and sound nutritional principles will diminish your codependency with eyeglasses, and your eyesight may become progressively sharper as well.

Have you ever considered the possibility of improving your vision by actually working hand-in-hand with the blur itself, and utilizing the blur to assist in monitoring the whole process of improving eyesight? In light of our modern- day lifestyle, it would be unreasonable for most of us to consider giving up your eyeglasses altogether since the unaccustomed blur would be too much for you to handle.

But, as is true in most life situations, there are alternatives available. How about having a pair of eyeglasses made up that are slightly weaker than the normal 20/20 prescription, say 20/40 at a distance of 20 feet?

This means that your degree of vision "fitness" would be 84%, and you would have to contend with only 16% blur. For many, this is much less blur compared to not wearing any devices.

By bringing vision-fitness principles into your daily routine, you can train your brain,

eyes, and muscles to make up the 16% deficiency. After a period of time, you will be seeing 20/20 through this vision-fitness prescription and you will have begun the journey of freeing yourself from strong eyeglasses or contacts.

When you are wearing vision-fitness eyeglasses (a 20/40 or reduced lens prescription), the visual centers of the brain can benefit from the biofeedback nature of your eyes. You will discover that what you eat, how you exercise, your thoughts, and daily living can have positive, negative or neutral effect upon your vision.

As the process deepens and you apply new strategies for seeing, you will return to your eye doctor and obtain further reductions in lens power. Imagine obtaining glasses that are weaker rather than stronger.

As you decrease the strength of the lenses before your eyes, memories from your past may begin to surface. It is not uncommon for my patients to report periods in their lives where there were life situations they had difficulty seeing. It was as if their internal perceptions turned into a survival way of looking, a pulling inward (nearsightedness) or a pushing outward (farsightedness).

In other cases, the perceptual blocks were such that the structures in the eyeball itself became dis-eased (e.g. glaucoma, cataracts, muscular degenerations and so on)

As adults, when they faced their survival perceptions their natural vision fitness returned. They realized they had made the best decision possible at the time, and they could now face those situations.

Are you willing to see beyond the traditional model of vision care and begin your self-help approach.



In January 1991 the AEHA in B.C. held its first meeting with 6 people attending the March meeting featuring Dr. Craig Wagstaff attracted more than 60 people. This surely demonstrates the growing concern about the health of our home environments.

The Environmental Protection Agency estimates that more than 15% of the population is chemically sensitive owing to the chemicals that they have ingested. Within the medical community there is ongoing controversy about environmental hypersensitivity as the symptoms experienced from incitants such as pesticides, chlorine, vehicle exhausts, paints, etc., cannot be verified by testing methods. Reactions to natural inhalants (dusts, moulds, pollens, and animal dander) and to some foods (milk, eggs, nuts) are mediated by Immunoglobin E, a type of antibody produced by the body in allergic responses.

Physicians who practice "clinical ecology" believe that there are specific components of the environment which make people ill. These can be found in food, clothing, drugs, air, and water as well as in the home work and play environment.

The AEHA can provide you with valuable information, put you in touch with others who understand the problems and cant assist you with finding your solution by:

- \* increasing awareness of environmental conditions which may be hazardous;
- finding sources of less contaminated food, water, clothing, and household furnishings;
- assisting with lifestyle adjustments for the environmentally hypersensitive;
- \* providing information & educating others;
- \* supporting a branch in your community
- \* facilitating self-help groups

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
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# LEE PULOS, Ph.D.

ee Pulos was born and raised in Calgary, Alberta. He attended U.C.L.A., majoring in psychology and earned his doctorate in Clinical Psychology at the University of Denver. Upon graduation he held clinical appointments at the Universities of Indiana and Wisconsin. In 1962, Lee entered private practice in Vancouver, British Columbia, and was subsequently appointed clinical Assistant Professor in the Department of Psychiatry, University of British Columbia — a position he held for fourteen years. In 1966, he was awarded a Diplomate in Clinical Psychology by the American Board of Professional Psychology.



n 1970, Lee launched his career as a businessman and entrepreneur. He and his brothers started the Old Spaghetti Factory restaurant chain —a venture-that prospered to become a 20 million dollar a year, 22 location operation in Canada, the United States and Australia. Serving as the Chief Operating Officer, he helped create one of the best bottom lines in the industry —before selling to the Keg Restaurants in 1980.

During the same period, Lee was Sports Psychologist for Team Canada at the Commonwealth Games and worked with a number of Olympic and professional athletes. He also conducted a number of clinics for coaches and national teams.

# POLARITY THERAPY ENERGY AS A HEALING ART

The Gentle Art of Hands-on-Healing

Very often, people will ask me, "What is Polarity Therapy anyway?" and somewhere in the recesses of my mind I search for a simple sentence that will clearly and concisely answer that question. However, I have not yet come up with a "one sentence" to that question.

Polarity Therapy is about 'life' energy. 'Polarity' is the law of opposites, i.e., positive and negative, contraction and expansion, or the yin yang energy.

To grasp the idea of this 'life' energy, I would like you to visualize your body as a large circuit board, with several fields of energy surrounding and permeating your body.



One of these fields is called the 'long line' energy and comes in through the top of the head and divides into five fields on each side of the body, one for each of the digits/toes and pulses its way throughout your entire body. Its function is to regulate and monitor the physiology of the body. The long line currents carry the energies of the mind into the body and govern the function of the five senses and relates to the central nervous system and movement of energy through the cranial rhythm.

Another field of energy emanates from the shoulders to the opposite hip in a lazy eight fashion.



There is also a 'spiral' field that begins at the umbilicus to encompass the whole of the energy system and it functions to provide the quality of energy for movement, warmth and healing. It governs the distribution of internal vital energy throughout the body. It relates to the sympathetic nervous system.


There is the 'transverse' energy field that moves transversely around the body and its function is one of intercommunication and



binding. It helps to relate the periphery of the energy system to the core and relates to the parasympathetic nervous system.

The Chakras are points of swirling of energy. There are six chakras in the body, located along the spine. (The crown (or 7th) chakra is not a pulsating energy centre, but is rather a centre of potential expansive enlightenment.) The sixth chakra, located in the

centre of the forehead is mental. The bottom five are physical and are located at the throat, chest, solar plexus, pelvis and base of spine.



These six Centres can be visualized as pulsating orbs which both suck energy in and push energy out of their centres. Each chakra acts like a two-way electrical transformer pulsating energy from the core to periphery and from the periphery to the core.

These energy flows would be better visualized as pulsations of light moving in specific patters, that as moving energy in channels.

## POLARITY THERAPY, IN ITS SIMPLEST FORM

Is to release the congestion or blockage within the body and direct "energy" through its truine (positive, negative and neutral) relationships.

This energy does not flow in channels, or along nerve fibres, but moves in waves of expansion and contraction in interrelated and harmonic patterns.

A Polarity Therapist assesses where this "energy" is blocked and uses fingertip pressure on a positive and negative points simultaneously to release blockages.

If these 'energies' can move along its given pathway without interruption in its flow, we experience marvellous physical, mental and emotional well being. This 'life energy' nourishes the body, promotes relaxation, rejuvenates and calms the mind. However, when this energy flow ''pools'' or become ''blocked'', we begin to experience aches, pain, tension, stiffness, and constriction and eventually dis-ease conditions will surface. Those big tight knots that we often have in our shoulders or neck are pools of energy that has ceased to flow - and these are warning signals from your body advising you that it needs some attention.

Polarity Therapy is a holistic system enabling people to rediscover their health and inner beauty in a gentle, powerful and subtle way through contacting positive and negative points on the body to release the energy blockages. The Polarity Therapist acts as a catalyst to get your energy moving by pinpointing the "switches" or "cross-over" lines of force on the body in an acupressure fashion through fingertip pressure on exact points.

While fingertip pressure is the mainstay of the bodywork, there are also some massage style motions and structural work. The fingertip pressure influences the metabolism of the body, while the massage and structural work affects how the body parts fit together and affect posture and grace of movement patterns.

As a Polarity Therapist, I view the entire body as an energy field with specific currents and patterns and I endeavor to balance the body's energy and have all parts of the body communicating with each other. A Polarity session usually is an hour in duration where you lie on a massage table fully clothed. At the end of a session, you are deeply relaxed (mind and body) and at the same time paradoxically rejuvenated and energized. (continues next page)

While some view Polarity as a powerful tool for stress reduction and experience profound improvement in their overall sense of well being, the also experience what I call the 'Domino effect'. The Domino effect occurs when a person seeks out a Polarity Therapist because they may have improved after just a few polarity sessions. For example, they may find that they no longer get headaches, or a stiffness they felt upon arising in the morning has vanished, or their shoulders/back/legs/feet no longer hurt, their posture has improved noticeably and the usual fatigue that they lived with daily is no longer there. Very often their eyes sparkle and skin colour improves as energy is now moving freely throughout their body. These events occur naturally within the body as energy blocks are released and you body's own healing power begins its journey back to vibrant health. (Perhaps we should take a moment each day to give thanks to our body for always working non-stop for us without any conscious effort on our behalf - even though we continuously abuse it.)

We are all aware that Medical Reports state that over 80% of all illness is caused by stress (a figure that goes up every year) and since stress prevents the brain from functioning at full capacity, consciously, or subconsciously, the fact that Polarity Therapy reduces stress very effectively can hardly be glibly dismissed.

Polarity Therapy is about 'energy' - so it is important to realize that all thought is 'energy'. All you thoughts are recorded in your body. You cannot have a thought without a feeling being registered in your body. So, let's look at attitude and its relation to your Health. Cultivating positive thought patterns is an important key to health and happiness. All tensions, energy blocks, attitudes and sickness begin in the mind, then filter down and manifest in the body. The body receives all the blame without our realizing that all dis-ease process originated in the mind through our own thinking. Negative emotions such as fear, anger, jealousy, anxiety and stress, etc. create all sickness by stopping the free flow of 'life-force energy' within the body. Negative thoughts from grooves in the mind. As you eliminate negative thought patterns, you will improve your physical, mental and emotional well-being. A healthy body is the reflection of a healthy mind and the two are inseparable - you are what you think about.

The above is a very brief explanation of Polarity Therapy. Polarity therapy includes diet, lifestyle, specific exercises, body constitution, and of course, attitude. I began this article stating that I could not answer in one sentence all the aspects of Polarity - perhaps now you can see why. It is like the petals on a flower - all the petals make up the whole - or you can focus on one petal at a time.

There are many methods of attaining a quality state of health. Each of the methods may get you to your destination: it is a matter of preference, appropriateness and choice. I have found that Polarity has been the most effective for me - both in the giving and receiving.

What I want to leave you with is to have a little more love and respect for the majesty of your body, as well as a desire to listen to, nurture and care for your body - Remember, if you don't take care of your body, you have no place to live!

TRADITIONAL

Acupuncture is part of the traditional medicine of China which includes herbal medicine, exercise, massage and diet.

Acupuncture is a method of using five needles to stimulate invisible lines of energy channels or meridians running beneath the surface of the skin. Moxibustion, the stimulation of energy by the use of burning herbs, is often used to supplement acupuncture.

Chinese medicine treats the whole person, taking into account not only the disease symp-


toms but also the age, habits, physical and emotional traits and all other aspects of the individual, putting together an overall picture of the patient in order to evaluate patterns of disharmony.

Symptoms, on their own are often unimportant as they are part of the syndrome of harmony or disharmony making up the whole person. Part of the assessment involves tongue and pulse diagnosis which are highly refined in Chinese medicine. The pulse is felt at the wrist on both arms on the radial artery and its strength, rhythm and quality indicate the balance of energy in the organ systems and the state of the disease. The tongue is observed for its shape, colour, movement and coating indicating the progression and degree of the disharmony.

Qi, unknown in Western medicine is the vital energy of the body, for example, it keeps the blood circulating, warms the body and fights disease. Qi flows through the channels forming a network linking all parts and functions together to work as one unit. When Oi moves smoothly through the channels, there is health, but if the flow is blocked or too weak or too strong then there is illness or symptoms of subtle changes that we accept as common to everyone but are not. By inserting thin needles into particular points on the channels a change in a part or function of the body can occur, not only in the physical aspect but the emotional and spiritual aspects of the individual as well.

Many things can upset the balance of the body and disturb the flow of Qi:

- emotional states, such as stress, worry, fear, grief, etc.



- diet, malnutrition, overeating, too much of one type of food.
- eating erratically or in a state of tension
- drugs, alcohol, tobacco, marijuana, wrongly prescribed medicine or medicine with side effects, even tea and coffee can overstimulate the body
- weather conditions such as cold, damp, wind, heat, etc. and particularly sudden changes in weather
- exercise and rest too
  little or too much of either
  trauma, hereditary factors, poisons, epidemics.

Just as there are


people who do not respond to drugs so there are those who do not respond to acupuncture. If the body is severely depleted, as in wasting diseases, there are no reserves to call on and healing is very slow. Acupuncture is usually known for its treatment of chronic problems, but is particularly effective in treating acute and painful disorders, and can be combined with Western drug therapy, or can be used to eliminate dependence on drugs for chronic conditions, the drugs being gradually reduced as the effect of acupuncture builds up.

In the West, public attention has tended to focus on acupuncture as a means of eliminating pain or for treating obesity or smoking, but acupuncture is most effective for general therapeutic purposes and for treating many common diseases. It is also very effective with mental, emotional and spiritual changes and balance, promoting and enhancing awareness and providing nourishing energies so that people will feel internally stronger and in less need of defensive postures.

In my practice of acupuncture I work with where you have come from, who you are, and where you want to go on all levels, physical, emotional and spiritual, helping you to help yourself.







There are a number of deep bodywork systems available for those interested in exploring this way of working with oneself, including Rolfing, Postural Integration Rebalancing, and Hellerwork. It seems that all these approaches aim to unite and harmonize the body/mind through deep tissue bodywork and other integrated techniques. It is quite well known today that the body and mind act as one unit. Whatever is going on in mind is also going on in body: there is no escape from one to the other. For various reasons, however, many of us have created a kind of split between or within body and mind; we have blocked out, numbed or suppressed various parts of ourselves. We use our minds and bodies in ways which create poor health and a limited experience of ourselves. Once the body/mind is reintegrated through deep bodywork there is an experience of greater wholeness, awareness, presence, energy, and enjoyment in life.



What would you expect if you were to book a session of Rebalancing? The length of a Rebalancing session is usually 1 1/2 hours. It takes place in a warm, private room. The client is made comfortable with pillows, clean sheets, and a blanket if necessary.

Usually there is some verbal exchange to find out what direction the session will take and sometimes a body reading so the Rebalancer can see the physical energy flow, energy blocks, physical alignments and misalignments in the client's body.

Usually before any deep tissue work is done the Rebalancer has made a connection with the client and helped the client relax through breath work, joint release, rocking, light stroking, or a combination of all of these.

The session moves on, usually into some deep work, relaxing strong muscle holding patterns in the body originating from various causes throughout one's life. The last part of each session is integration. This involves joining parts of the body together and grounding so the client feels balanced in his or her new state before leaving the room.

Some of the many benefits a person can derive from Rebalancing are the following:

#### Relaxation:

The deeper the level or relaxation the greater the energy flow throughout the body/mind, which enables a person to feel more connected with the self. When tension is released, energy can flow more freely to be used in any activity the person engages. Relaxation gives ease, confidence, and enjoyment of life.

#### **Emotional Release:**

Emotional holding in various parts of the body can cause tightness, misalignment, illness and pain. Sometimes emotional patterns have been stored in the body from childhood or absorbed from parents and others, thus causing habitual holding patterns in the body/mind. In a sensitive and living way, Rebalancing unlocks the emotional patterns that affect a person's well-being.

#### Recovery from Injury or Operation:

Following injury or operation the body/mind can go into a reactive state of self-protection. Though this is a natural response it is not a healthy one if we stay there too long tying the body up in tension and protection. The Rebalancer can help the person let go of the protection, get in touch with the injury, the mental and/or physical pain, and deal with it from a different perspective.

#### Addictions:

Bodywork helps one become familiar with their body/mind, relax into oneself and develop a sense of wellness. Old dependencies drop away as a more positive and fulfilling body image, or sense of oneself develops.

#### Touch:

Being touched and touching are wonderful experiences for most people. Deep touch when done in a skilled, sensitive way, can be the very link between body and mind necessary for the healing experience to take place.

#### Education:

A Rebalancing session can offer a wonderful learning experience. It teaches us new ways to experience ourselves on physical, emotional, mental and spiritual levels. The Rebalancer attempts to educate his/her clients in being able to create these experiences for themselves and to integrate them into daily life.




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# **Reclaiming Wholeness & Balance**


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

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# The Legend of WESAK

At the Full Moon in Taurus on April 28th this year, we celebrate the festival of Wesak, the high point in humanity's yearly cycle, a time, at which expansions of consciousness become possible which are not otherwise possible, and a great spiritual event which provides each of us the opportunity to act as channels, stepping down spiritual energies which have a powerful effect upon the human race.

At the time of the Wesak Full Moon, the Christ, focussing in Himself the aspiration of the entire planet, and the Buddha focussing in Himself the downpouring spiritual energies, work in closest co-operation to open a channel of communication between humanity and God. Year after year, the Buddha returns at great cost [to transmit through the Christ renewed spiritual life] in a ceremonial blessing which takes just eight minutes from the time He appears as a faint speck in the sky to the time He receded into the distance.

Legend has it that at the time of the Wesak full moon, a group of lamas, pilgrims, and holy men gather in the bowl of a bottle-shaped valley lying at a rather high attitude in the foot-hills of the Himalayas-Tibet Ranges. Close to the "neck" of the bottle is a huge flat rock before which stand "the three Great Lords" - the Christ in the center, the Manu, the Lord of living forms, on the right and the Master Rakoczi, the Lord of Civilization, on His left. These Three face the rock, upon which rests a great crystal bowl, full of water. Behind them are ranged in concentric circles the members of the planetary Hierarchy, from the Masters of the wisdom, representing the aggregate of perfected humanity, to the disciples, aspirants and world servers, some of whom are present in their physical bodies. Others are present in their spiritual bodies and in a dream state.

As the hour of the full moon approaches, a stillness settles upon the crowd and then certain ritualistic movements take place to the sound of esoteric words as phrases called mantrams. A potent vibration is set up which has the effect of awakening the souls of those present and lifting the entire group into a great act of spiritual demand, readiness and expectancy, which is focussed in the Christ as humanity's Invocation.

Just a few minutes before the exact time of the full moon a tiny speck is seen in the sky which comes nearer and grows in clarity until the form of Buddha can be seen seated in the cross-legged position, clad in His saffron-coloured robe, bathed in light and colour, and with His hand extended in blessing. When He arrives at a point exactly over the great rock, the Christ intones a great mantram - used only once a year, at the festival - and the blessing of love and wisdom is poured forth from the highest cosmic centre.

The entire group of people in the valley have fallen upon their faces and remain prostrate until the Buddha has again receded into a tiny speck which eventually disappears from the sky. They rise as the water in the bowl is distributed in tiny portions to the Masters, disciples and crowd, which silently disperse and return to their place of service.

So runs this ancient legend, describing a beautiful "water ceremony of communion" which is the symbolic indication of the New Age, the Aquarian Age, the age of the "Water Carrier" now beginning. As we recite the Great Invocation at the time of the Festival, let us regard ourselves as vessels, as recipients of as much of that inflowing spiritual force as we can contain.

Since it was founded in 1988 Gulding Hands Recreation Society has worked to promote and foster the values of environmental education and outdoor recreation in a healthy society.

Our Tipi Camp, which is being operated as a model for a low impact recreation network around Kootenay Lake, has grown

in form and spirit. We now have three tipis for guest accommodation, a larger kitchen, and several nearby hiking trails to enhance the relaxing, recreational activities for which we are already known.

During 1990, families, individuals and several groups of school children enjoyed land and water excursions on and around Pilot Peninsula. Our volunteers hosted interpretive tours to local heritage sites, wetlands, and old growth forests.

Our society is also working with a local owner-operated on a plan which result in a low impact system of mountain huts for winter ski touring and summer ridgewalking. This is a first step to a mosaic of operator zones accessing the recreation potential of the region. It furthers another of our society's goals - creating local employment in the recreation industry.


Last August and September more than 100 person attended educational Programs and a similar series is planned this summer.

At a local level we initiated a composting "Worm Farm" and paper recycling program in the Crawford Bay School, sent recycling information newsletter to area residents, cleaned two local dumps, and donated funds for student participation at environmental conferences.

Now in its third year the Guiding Hands Recreation Society has established working relationships with many groups, agencies and ministries. Some of these projects have included Personnel Training and Job Creation in the Outdoor Recreation industry, public education and fundraising for wildlife habitats, trail building projects, lobbying for various wildness area, and act as local advisors on environmental concerns, plus we document and protect archaeological, cultural and natural heritage sites on Kootenay Lake.

We are also working with the Twin Island Friendship Centre of Salmon Arm to create Friendship Trail experience for marketing in the US and Europe and assisted in the development of educational programs to help people connect with the earth though "hands on" experiences in nature through the World Peace University, etc, etc,.

### **UNSUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT**

Please be aware of the effects our economic decisions have on our future. Our children depend upon us to protest the water, land and air.

In the Similkameen at Princeton Railex Incorporated continues to enjoy support from local politicians for a proposal to burn trainloads of coal and Vancouver's municipal solid waste.

We must all say "no" to Railex's plans. The burning of coal causes acid rain and dry deposition which kills forests and agricultural land. We must protect the ecosystem from these hazards because our economy is dependent on a healthy environment for tourism, forestry and agriculture.

There is no safe way to burn Vancouver's municipal solid waste. Transporting Vancouver's garbage to Princeton does nothing to encourage "at source" reduction of waste (plastics, packaging) or to encourage recycling programs.

Princeton Power and Light Company has an interesting plan involving smaller-sized hydroelectric dams on the Similkameen River. Small hydro-electric projects should be supported so long as they do not compromise the quality of the water or soil downstream and so long as they are developed to meet local needs.

### HAVE YOU LOST YOUR VOTE?

A few months ago a new B.C. voter registration system was slid by. In the past we could register to vote on election day. No more.

Maybe some of us haven't registered to vote. Maybe we have been so angry and disillusioned with government that we have vowed never to vote gain. After all, it only encourages them!

People who have been this angry are often people of good conscience who have changed their minds on election day and decided to give the system "one more shot". This time they will not be allowed to register. They will not be allowed to vote.

The man responsible for this significant initiative in voter registration is Mr. Elwood Veitch, a Zalmoid appointed to replace Finance Minister, Mel Cuvelier (who has since been re-incarnated).

Don't get caught on Election Day. Call your local government agent to make sure you are on the voter's list.

# Focus on Women

We have met the enemy and she is us.

I have had some painful experiences in my relationships to women lately. And the pain I feel I'm sure is directly proportional to the growth I'm experiencing. I realize that I assume a great deal. I trust them. I believe them to be my ideological contemporaries, with the same perspectives on the world, the same social values, the same goals. And some of us probably do share some or all of these realities. But a lot of us don't. In my own idealistic myopia, I secretly want to call every woman sister. In fact, I'm still looking for her, the sister I never had. I want all women to be sisters, in the wonderful warm, intimate, supportive sense of the word. I'm sure there is another side of sisterhood, the struggles, the jealousies, the bitterness and quarrels, but the underlying sense of connectedness, the bonds of blood and kinship are always there.

When I think of "women's liberation" it has always conjured up visions of some kind of shining city in the future, where the women are all beautiful and strong, empowered and laughing. Sisters, Goddesses, all. But the dream is quite different from the reality. There is occasionally strength and beauty, but the laughter and empowerment are still for the most part illusive for us all. It's hard to become something you have never known. Just what exactly is a "liberated woman" in the fullest, truest sense of the word? Power and strength are still, even in the women's movement, defined in the terms we have learned them; manipulation, force, coercion, the ability to argue, conflict.

I feel sometimes that as feminists, we are participating in some kind of intellectual exercise in which we somehow set ourselves apart and above the "average" woman, to try to bring enlightenment and liberation to our communities. Often, in my experiences to date, this flexing of mental muscle is virtually disconnected from the exercise of another essential part of ourselves... our hearts. In our rush to prove to ourselves and the world at large that we are equal in all things to our male counterparts, we have often fallen into the trap of becoming that which we supposedly despise.

A favourite past-time that (mea culpa, I confess to having participated) women indulge in, on occasion is to complain about men and their general lack of awareness. In one such typical conversation these complaints could very easily be voiced: Men don't talk about their feelings. Men don't have any feelings. Men are isolated. Men are competitive. Men are uncomfortable with intimacy. Men are evil, brutish, violent, insensitive and totally unredeemable creatures. Men are unquestionably the problem and therefore the enemy. However, all of these despicable features are not the sole province of men. Indeed the arbitrary assigning of these qualities to the male gender is sexist behaviour in the extreme.

One of the supposedly male qualities of competition is very much alive and well among women and present in the women's movement, among feminists. Competition among women is pervasive and deadly. Part of it is as result of our conditioned responses, the fact that our particular political socio-economic order is based on competition, and because of this conditioning, competition is a more familiar route to take than the less charted course of co-operation and consensus. Ah yes, consensus. Oh brave new world where consensus is the catchword, the magical phrase that all feminist organizations and environmental groups use to describe their decisionmaking processes. What passes for consensus, is, I am afraid, a very poor and pale imitation of the real thing. Often times, I have seen "consensus" reached after either sheer exhaustion has set in, or where we in fact are very busy being "nice" when in actuality the meeting is aswirl with unspoken and suppressed emotional energy (particularly the case with women's groups), and as a consequence, the end result is often failure. When we are particularly task oriented, as is often the case when struggling for funding, or trying to change the planet overnight, we ignore what is euphemistically termed the "touchy/feely" aspect of group process; which means forging the bonds of trust and confidentiality, of caring and compassion and respect that are essential to the establishment of true consensus and cooperation. Given that we are trying to make a new world in which every life has value, and every act has significance, in which the whole is greater than the sum of its parts, then we must take into account that each one of us bring to every encounter... whether meeting or ritual or Sunday picnic... a complete collection of ideas, thoughts, feelings, dreams and despair... Because rugged individualism has not worked, but left so many of us stranded in despair and grief, I believe that we come to the group process with the hope that we may be healed, and that in co-operation we may actually begin to affect the changes we so dearly wish to see. Many of us spend a great deal of our modern lives in meetings. And how much do we actually accomplish?

The greatest obstacle to the advancement of women is women themselves. We are our own worst enemies. We are, after all, the majority. Why is it we are still economically disadvantaged, and rapidly becoming poorer? Why aren't there free daycare centres on every block and why are we still not safe in our homes or on the streets? Because we have not enmasse demanded these things. Because we have not acted as a group. Because we have not acted as if we believe in our own value... that we are equal to men, in every way. We have not learned to trust each other, and with good reason. We are as yet crippled by our own perceptions and judgements, and our own unwillingness to activate the spiritual component missing in all our lives. The women's movement has often been accused of being racist, a movement that has greatly benefited white middle class women. Unfortunately I believe this to be true. There are a great many women not served by Women's Centres or by the Women's Movement directly and many of them are people who could benefit greatly from a supportive network of women..., mothers, single women, older women, poor women, young women, native women, disabled women. We do not see ourselves as connected, as related... as essential to each other.

An appropriate description for the victimization of women by women is horizontal violence. It is easier to attach another woman if you are a woman than to see to the root of your situation, the fact that we have surrendered our power for centuries, lock, stock and liberty. We have colluded in our own oppression. One of the greatest things one woman can do for another is to expand her sense of

possibilities. Another is to support each other in all our endeavours to grow and change and to become more.

One of my fonder, wilder fantasies is to participate in a day-long general strike of all women in North America. Just one day. Northern America would come to rather an abrupt halt. No schools. No stores. No telephones. No buses. No taxis. No restaurants. No banks. No supermarkets. No bars. No dentists or doctors offices. And what would we strike for? Why stop the world for a day? For equal pay. For universal daycare. For an end to poverty and hunger and exile and homelessness. For an end to the destruction of the planet. For love of ourselves and each other and the life that we bear... International Women's Day would be appropriate. Easy to remember. It would be an amazing act of solidarity. An amazingly empowering act for all women. A wonderful exercise in dropping the distinctions, the judgements, the competitiveness, the lack of trust and compassion that so badly divide us. Just think. Upper-middle management women in linen suits dancing in the streets with bag ladies. Mary Collins and Barbara MacDougall with lapfuls of sticky toddlers. Super Valu cashiers disguised as Nellie McClung, Emmy Pankhurst. Sitting down to find out what consensus really is. Joy rising up like smoke. Change dancing with the wind. This is a serious fantasy, folks. If you're interested, write to me, care of Issues.

Until that day, when we can truly join hands and call each other sisters, I have vowed that I will never again devote myself to a group of women (or men) where there is not what I would call an agreed upon spiritual purpose for our coming together, the force or the love that binds us all, that is at the centre of all things. For my heart, as well as my head, needs to be fully engaged in order to travel to that beautiful shining city of my dreams.



humanity's purestate which was first lost to "civilized" culture about 7000 years ago in Mesopotamia.

Fortunately, some people still keep the world the way it was given to us. Mother Earth's keepers are her few surviving, indigenous cultures!

The indigenous culture of the North West Pacific area of North America was overpowered by the European conquer ers only about 100 years ago. Although suppressed by European culture, Native

culture remained active and is now undergoing a strong revival.

Red Cloud saw the spiritual and physical re-birth of Mother Earth and self in finding our spiritual essence and source, in rediscovering Native culture and adapting it to a modern context, and in a harmonious sharing of spiritual wealth between the Native culture and the many immigrant cultures of North America.

Red Cloud died in 1987, but the annual Gathering founded by him remained. The 1991 Re-Birth of Mother Earth Gathering will again be held over the long Canada Day weekend from June 27 to July 1 at the traditional Gathering grounds on Whatshan Settlement Road of Highway 6 near Edgewood, B.C.. The unstructured, events occur spontaneously and will be duly announced. Let us join in joy and harmony to amass our spiritual powers toward a rebirth of Mother Earth and self!

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The **EN'OWKIN CENTRE** of Penticton is an educational centre for the six Okanagan bands of British Columbia. The aim of this centre is the general development of Native culture. What fascinates me about it is their SCHOOL OF WRITING which is exploring the unique literary forms emerging from the Native oral, cultural tradition.

Thinking is shaped and limited by language. The destructiveness of Roman/Western culture is entrenched in its languages. Our words and concepts divide, our language is linear and divisive, which tends to make our actions linear, divisive and destructive. Western language is devoid of circular or wholistic concepts and words.

Not so with Native language which is full of circular and wholistic concepts. Take the word EN'OWKIN the Okanagan word which was used as the for their education centre. EN'OWKIN means: collective creation: tribal creation: making together: creating together. There are many more wholistic words in the Okanagan and other Native languages. This difference between words in the Okanagan and other Native languages. This difference between their and our languages is rooted in the difference of consciousness.

The Consciousness underlying Western culture is individual consciousness. We see ourselves as individuals separated from other individuals and the world. We suffer from that separateness, and make up for it by revolving the world around the separated individual which we think we are, thereby isolating ourselves from the world and its beings. The thoughts, words, concepts and actions of our culture are egocentred, divisive and destructive.

The consciousness of Native tribal culture, on the other hand, is tribal consciousness. Members of a tribal culture see themselves not as separate individuals but as individuals united into a tribe. To think for the tribe, to act for the tribe, to exist for the tribe, to actually think of themselves as the tribe rather than the individual is the outstanding feature of tribal consciousness. But there is more to Native culture.

The spiritual consciousness of Native culture sees and experiences a cyclical and circular way of being, the interconnectedness and unity of all life. All matter has spirit, and every physical being is also a spiritual being. There is no separation between physical and spiritual, and no dividing lines separating one being form another. In Native culture, an individual does not exist. The feeling of individual separateness and isolation which plagues Western culture is not part of Native culture.

Paradoxically, Native culture allows, even promotes, individual uniqueness. Native culture sees in every individual and every being, animate or inanimate, a unique expression of the Great Spirit. The Creator is in every being, and expresses ITself uniquely through every being. This makes the Native culture into a creative culture.

Because Natives see themselves in everything they observe and experience, their self transcends the individual self. This transcendent consciousness is created and maintained through the telling and re-telling of mythology, and through participation in ritual and ceremony, during which the transcendence of the individual self and the

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unity with the spiritual world and other beings is actually experienced. Native spirituality is taught not by dogma but by direct experience, which is far more effective and persuasive than indoctrination.

I think that we, the Canadians of European origin, sorely need the wisdom of Canada's aboriginal culture. I think the developed world desperately needs the wisdom of the few surviving indigenous cultures. We may think and write about spiritual renewal and a greening of our planet, as I do in this article, but these are just words. Although some of us practice what we say, the practice is not general, is not alive in our culture, is not a functioning, everyday part of practical, everyday culture.

But the Native culture in our corner of the world is still functioning. The spiritual renewal which we envision, the greening of the planet which we hope and work for is still practiced daily in a working, preserving, earth-connected, spiritual culture: NATIVE CULTURE.

So let us ask our Native Sisters and Brothers to forgive us all those terrible wrongs that our ancestors have committed against theirs. Let us do our best to right these wrongs as much as possible. Let us openly acknowledge the superiority of their culture and tell them that we need their practical wisdom to survive. Let us humbly ask them to share their culture with us.

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
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
